Evaluation Criteria for RFP for Phase 3 Landscaping and Irrigation Improvements

1. Personnel (10 Points)

Locations of the firm's headquarters or permanent office in relation to the project; capabilities and experience of key personnel, including the project manager and field supervisor; present ability to manage this project; evaluation of existing work load; proposed staffing levels, etc.

2. Proposer's Experience, Bonding Capacity, and Available Equipment (10 Points)

Past record and experience of the Proposer in similar projects; volume of work previously performed by the firm; past performance for other community developments districts in other contracts; character, integrity, reputation of Proposer, ability to obtain a payment and performance bond; availability of equipment necessary for the project etc.

3. Understanding of Scope of Work and Schedule of Values (10 Points)

Extent to which the proposal demonstrates: (1) an understanding of the District's needs for the services requested, (2) the ability to integrate the project with adjacent developments, and (3) an understanding and compliance with the schedule of values outlined in the Proposal Package.

4. Schedule (10 Total Points)

Demonstration of Proposer's understanding (through presentation in the proposal of a milestone schedule) of how to meet the required substantial and final completion dates. Consideration will be given to proposers that indicate an ability to credibly complete the project in advance of the required substantial and final completion dates without a premium cost for accelerated work.

5. Price (60 Total Points)

Points available for price will be allocated as follows: 60 Points will be awarded to the Proposer submitting the lowest total proposal, (i.e., the summation of the unit price extensions using quantity estimates provided, the allowances shown, plus the proposal contractor's fee) for completing the work. All other proposals will receive a lower number of points based upon the difference between the proposal and the low proposal.

*60 points for the Price Evaluation Criteria were awarded to Sunrise as they were the lowest proposer and Cornerstone received points based on a proportionate percentage of price (Sunrise's # divided by Cornerstone's # and rounded to 2 digits. Then multiplying that # by 60 total points).

Sunrise's proposal was for **\$351,879.95** [total bid proposal was \$601,755.16 less the sod amount of \$249,875.21] and Cornerstone's proposal was for **\$390,314.68** [proposal did not include any sod].

Mr. Howell said he can reach out to Mr. Skidmore and ask if he can call the County to see if they are receptive before moving forward with costs and then finding out the County will not allow the project.

226 built and what the total would be after the buildout. Mr. Howell said he would need to check on
227 the current number, but the total would be approximately 832. A resident asked about stop signs
228 and if some of the construction signs over near the villas can be relocated because of line-of-
229 sight issues. There was a question about extra cleaning at the pool. Mr. Howell said that they
230 come every day. A resident said that part of the fence is broken; Mr. Howell said they were
231 aware of it and it will be fixed. The resident also mentioned that some signs are down; the
232 resident said she will send Mr. Howell an email of the locations. There was a question about a
233 second pool. Ms. Clark went over that the community will have the one pool and amenity center,
234 a couple of dog parks, and the trail. Residents also commented about kids being in the pool
235 during storms and people at the pool after hours; staff can look at the pool cameras when they are
236 made known about an incident and can get the sheriff involved if necessary. There were some
237 questions about the pool and capacity vs. the number of residents, the pool cleaning times, and
238 one of the pool pump motors being repaired.
