WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 189.016, Florida Statutes the Board desires to reallocate funds budgeted to reflect re-appropriated revenues and expenses during Fiscal Year 2021/2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD:

- 1. <u>Amending the General Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2021/2022</u>. The General Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2021/2022 is hereby amended as shown in **Exhibit** "A" attached hereto. The District Manager shall post the amended budget on the District's official website within 5 days after adoption and ensure it remains on the website for at least 2 years.
- 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

BUDGET INTRODUCTION

Background Information

The Cypress Preserve Community Development District is a local special purpose government authorized by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as amended. The Community Development District (CDD) is an alternative method for planning, financing, acquiring, operating and maintaining community-wide infrastructure in master planned communities. The CDD also is a mechanism that provides a solution to the State's needs for delivery of capital infrastructure to service projected growth without overburdening other governments and their taxpayers. CDDs represent a major advancement in Florida's effort to manage its growth effectively and efficiently. This allows the community to set a higher standard for construction along with providing a long-term solution to the operation and maintenance of community facilities.

The following report represents the District budget for Fiscal Year 2023, which begins on October 1, 2022. The District budget is organized by fund to segregate financial resources and ensure that the segregated resources are used for their intended purpose, and the District has established the following funds.

GENERAL FUND 001

FINANCIAL & ADMINISTRATIVE

District Manager

The District retains the services of a consulting manager, who is responsible for the daily administration of the District's business, including any and all financial work related to the Bond Funds and Operating Funds of the District, and preparation of the minutes of the Board of Supervisors. In addition, the District Manager prepares the Annual Budget(s), implements all policies of the Board of Supervisors, and attends all meetings of the Board of Supervisors.

District Engineer

Consists of attendance at scheduled meetings of the Board of Supervisors, offering advice and consultation on all matters related to the works of the District, such as bids for yearly contracts, operating policy, compliance with regulatory permits, etc.

Disclosure Reporting

On a quarterly and annual basis, disclosure of relevant district information is provided to the Muni Council, as required within the bond indentures.

Trustees Fees

This item relates to the fee assessed for the annual administration of bonds outstanding, as required within the bond indentures.

Auditing Services

The District is required to annually undertake an independent examination of its books, records and accounting procedures. This audit is conducted pursuant to State Law and the Rules of the Auditor General.

Postage, Phone, Fax, Copies

This item refers to the cost of materials and service to produce agendas and conduct day-to-day business of the District.

Public Officials Insurance

The District carries Public Officials Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.

Legal Advertising

This is required to conduct the official business of the District in accordance with the Sunshine Law and other advertisement requirements as indicated by the Florida Statutes.

Bank Fees

The District operates a checking account for expenditures and receipts.

Dues, Licenses & Fees

The District is required to file with the County and State each year.

Office Supplies

Cost of daily supplies required by the District to facilitate operations.

Website Administration

Cost of maintenance and administration of the District's website

LEGAL COUNSEL

District Counsel

Requirements for legal services are estimated at an annual expenditures on an as needed and also cover such items as attendance at scheduled meetings of the Board of Supervisor's, Contract preparation and review, etc.

GENERAL FUND 001

OTHER PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT

Waterway Management System

This item is for maintaining the multiple waterways that compose the District's waterway management system and aids in controlling nuisance vegetation that may otherwise restrict the flow of water.

Landscape Maintenance

The District contracts with a professional landscape firm to provide service through a public bid process. This fee does not include replacement material or irrigation repairs.

Plant Replacement Program

This item is for landscape items that may need to be replaced during the year.

Property & Casualty Insurance

The District carries \$1,000,000 in general liability and also has sovereign immunity.

Landscaping around the amenity center looks great, the Muhly grass needs some minor weed detailing, but the edging and plant fertility is great.



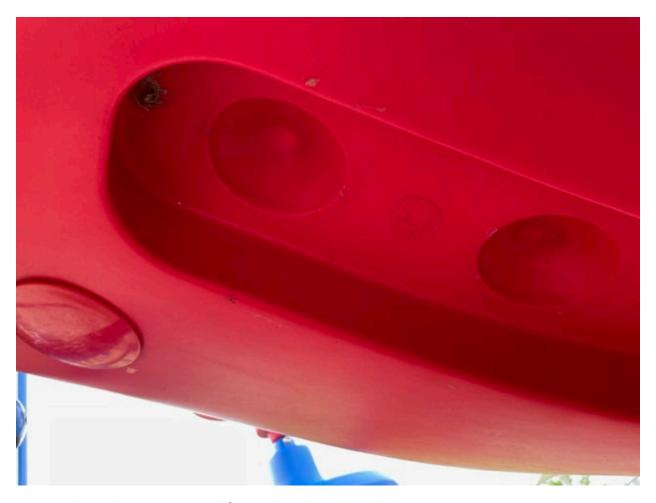
Amenity center looks great, the holiday lights are up as well.

Fakahatchee and Viburnum are looking good, the mulch is sparse here though.

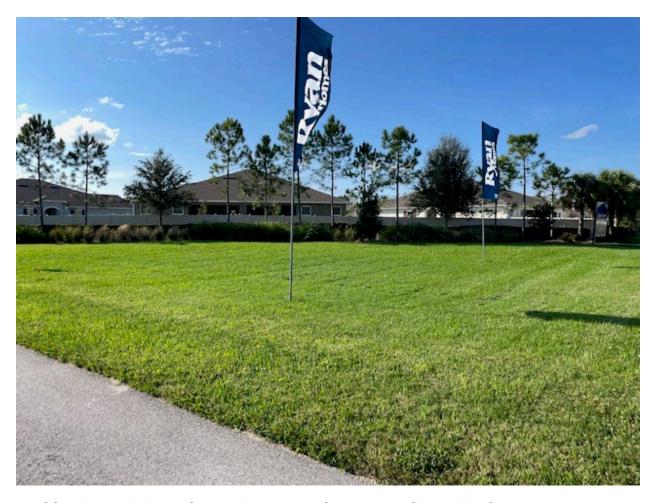

Turf fertility is high up front, there are a few spots of broadleaf weeds starting to form that Yellowstone will spray for. No issues spotted in the Fakahatchee, Muhly, Viburnum, and trees along the fence.



Turf quality is high, edging is good, the White Star Jasmine hedge is nicely shaped, the Fountain and Fakahatchee grass look good and the hedge is properly trimmed.



The Copperleaf and Podocarpus (though small, they are growing) look great around the palms. No weeds spotted.



Turf is great, annuals are vibrant, and the Thryallis hedge has filled in even more at Heron Hideaway Loop.



A few instances of broadleaf weeds spotted again in the turf at Heron Hideaway Lp.



A couple of weeds spotted in the Muhly grass here but the Coontie Palms, Copperleaf, and all other landscaping looks good. The Bahia grass will need to be treated for clover soon.



The leak in the reclaimed water line is currently being repaired by Pasco County Utilities.



The annuals here are looking great, the bush (Loropetalum I believe) is starting to look skimpy. Fertilization is recommended though it may just be seasonal. Olaf is looking sharp.



Anthills spotted at the base of the palmetto bush near the mailboxes, Yellowstone will treat at their next visit.



No issues spotted at the mailboxes.



Weeds will be getting pulled by Yellowstone in the landscaping beds in the parking lot.



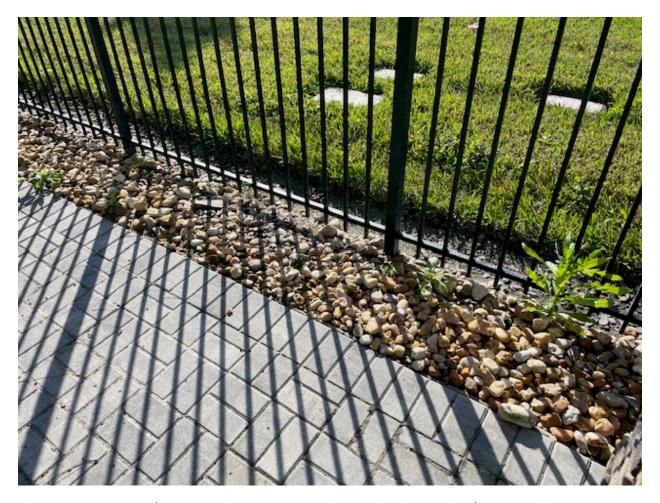
No issues spotted at the front of the amenity center.

Pond 13 is still looking clear of blue-green algae.



Pond 11 looks like it has been skipped and needs mowing. Yellowstone will mow it at their next visit.



Pond 10 looks good.



The Holly tree, Flax Lilies, and hedge all look good here. I would recommend laying new Bahia sod or seeding this area in the spring.



Quotes are being collected and the sidewalk is being analyzed for repair near the corner of Gliding Eagle and Grand Live Oak Blvd.



The Jasmine is filling in nicely here, the area needs better edging and the turf is going into dormancy for the winter.



Recommend requesting a quote to fill in the missing portion of the Boxwood hedge.



Fence line and turf is looking good further up Grand Live Oak blvd.



The Holly and Oak tree have been up-righted, the straps will need to be tightened.



No issues up near Osprey Glad Ter.





There are a few weeds growing amongst the beneficials in pond 16, it is minimal growth but it will be monitored.



Oak tree along pond 16 needs to be stood back up.



The Ilex look good but the larger hedges need to be shaped by Yellowstone at their next visit.



Pond 15 looks good.



Anthills are continually being treated by Yellowstone as needed.



The other pond 15 has some minor Filamentous algae growth. This is normal but will be monitored.



Most of the algae has cleared up in pond 14. Some Torpedo grass is starting to form.



There is a dead Maple on the south side of Grand Live Oak Blvd. A quote to replace will be requested.



The Plumbago is getting overgrown and needs to be trimmed, shaped, and properly edged.



Pond 21 looks good.



The Golden Dewdrops have been trimmed down.



The Red Fountain grass is growing nicely, though the area needs mulch.



Yellowstone is diagnosing the broken sprinkler head in the dog park at Grand Live Oak Blvd.





The Fakahatchee, Viburnum, Magnolias, and Crepe Myrtles are growing nicely near the end of Grand Live Oak Blvd.



Irrigation lines have been lain in the median at the end of Grand Live Oak Blvd.



The new monument is nearly completed at the North entryway and looks great so far.



Pond 20 looks good.



There is a pile of dead branches near pond 20 that Yellowstone will remove.
